PROJECT DESCRIPTION

27 participants aged 18-26 and leaders from 4 countries (6 per country): Poland, Lithuania, Spain, Romania and Bulgaria will take part in the youth exchange.

During the project implementation, participants will face the challenge of creating their own city game. To meet the challenge, they will have to acquire knowledge of game mechanics, gamification, storytelling and scenario creation. They will also gain skills in creating props and characterization. Creating your own city game will foster creativity and creative thinking. Participants will also strengthen soft skills - group work, leadership skills, communication, etc.

The main bus station "Dworzec Główny PKS" is close to the hostel, so you can walk on foot. Getting from the main train station "Dworzec Główny PKP" to the hostel requires you to also take the city bus.

COVID

Due to the current situation, participants can additionally use the kitchen in the accomodation for their own needs. There is no group cooking option for national evenings. Covid restrictions are constantly changing. We will present the current information on the Facebook group.

At this point (25.06.2022):

Rules for travelers coming to Poland

- Travelers are quarantined unless they test negative for COVID-19. The test will have to be performed no earlier than 48 hours before crossing the border.
- Type of test: PCR or antigenic.
- The solution will cover all means of transport: public and individual transport as well as pedestrian crossing of the border.
- Travelers who have been quarantined in Poland will be able to perform a test within 48 hours of crossing the border, the negative result of which will release them from quarantine.

Important! People vaccinated against COVID-19 are released from quarantine. This applies to people who have been issued a certificate of vaccination with a vaccine that has been authorized in the European Union. Full vaccination in the European Union will be accepted 14 days after the end of the vaccination process.

PARTICIPANTS' ROLE

Youth exchange involves the exchange of knowledge and experiences with other participants. Participants will take part in workshops. They are obliged to co-create the final result of the project - toolkit for youth workers, about usage of escape rooms in education

GROUP LEADERS' ROLE

Group leaders will have the added responsibility of being a person of reference for his/her national group, to be in contact with the sending and hosting organization in case of need, to attend planned meetings for group leaders during the YE, to support the group in all the logistic tasks. Each national team should select a group leader.
