SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

We all know places such as parks, squares, monuments or buildings that could be better valued in order to make a certain environment attractive, to tourists and to local communities, and to have an advantage not only from a landscape and visual point of view, but also from an economic and cultural point of view. One of the innovative solutions that we identified is how interesting and useful is the programming of "artist lights" or "light shows" projection on building facades (any type of monument, including located in remote cities or locations).

Using the light projection mapping for educational propose, to awareness young people about important social, cultural and environmental issues is new, attractive and innovative practice and tool, which can lead to positive changes in young people's behavior and skills, and can encourage young people's commitment to the development of their community.

In this context we will organize our training course is targeting youth workers, and young leaders to learn more about the creation and the use of this "modern art" for educational purposes, through various non formal learning methods. During the training they will learn how to use this art and innovative technique in their daily practices for youth work and to support youngsters take some attractivene initiatives for their community.

The course will take place in Lefkas, Greece, for 10 days (excluding 2 travel days).

OBJECTIVES

During this training course 36 participants from various European

and partner countries, with the help of dedicated trainers and experts, will be engaged in creative activities and in the theoretical and practical realization of workshops aiming to develop specific skills connected to youth education through light mapping show projections.

Through our training, we want to achieve the following objectives:

- 1- To develop the skills of youth workers you youth leaders in term of the use of light mapping for Non formal education for youth in order to become able to support

youngsters with innovative practices, by expanding to digital, social and entrepreneurial skills.

2- To create experimental shows & tutorials about light mapping show as outgoing results of the project in order to multiply this good practice among young people at European and international level.

3. To promote the technique of light mapping among young people as a vehicle to share meaningful messages connected to social, cultural and environmental issues, and enabling the strengthening of young people's civic engagement

ACTIVITIES:

The activities of the course will rely on the exchange of knowledge and good practices, the acquisition of up-to-date skills, with creativity and experimentation. Participants will learn by doing to effectively reach various youth audiences through new working methods to develop suitable support tools for youngsters.

The successive phase of the activities' plan will be as follows:

1- Getting to know each other; presentation of methods and activities: the first day will be dedicated to get to know each other and for team building. Participants will express their expectations and contributions. An intercultural evening will also take place.

2- Theoretical approach and exchange of experience & good practices through discussions and reflections. Participants will confront their experiences and develop their knowledge. They will get to know software related to projection and video mapping, with reflection sessions about supporting youngsters in this field.

3- Cultural Discovery & professional network: Participant will visit Lefkas, the hosting place, and local institutions and initiatives which are involved in the promotion of culture and patrimony, youth inclusion and local development.

4- Collective creativity: participant will design and prepare 4 mapping light show video projection on the following topics:

- Environment and sustainable development,
- Valorization of cultural heritage,
- Social inclusion (Focusing on the inclusion of young people),
- Intercultural dialogue and tolerance.

5- Implementing the light projections on the facades of remarkable buildings of Lefkas (Cultural centre/ Lefkas Library, Famous church, Musical school) inviting public of the local community.

6- Creating tutorial about the design and the use of mapping light show for Non formal education for youth.

6- “Open space” and final evaluation during the last day with a view to propose project ideas and build new European partnership within the frame of the ERASMUS+ program. Participants will also evaluate the course and prepare their Youthpass certificate.

EXPECTED RESULTS

- To create 4 mapping light show projections to broadcast on remarkable buildings of Lefkas, in order to attract, transmit messages though it and be visible to the members of the local community.
- To create tutorial on how to create these light show projection and how to use it in the context of non formal education for youth, in order to share this good practice on a larger scale.
- To develop profile and skills of youth workers in order to support youngsters with innovative, artistic and digital methods.
- To develop our European partnership, encouraging innovative practices of non formal education.

The minimum skills that each participant will develop by the end of the course:

- To become able to manipulate the program to create the mapping light show
- To have a clear vision how to use the mapping light show for and with young people in Non formal education context.

- To extend his professional network in European and international level.
- To have more knowledge about different cultures, different educational tools and different methods of working with young people in the context of non-formal education.

PROFILE OF THE PARTICIPANTS

The participants will be youth workers, educators, volunteers, young leaders, public officers, working for youth and in the field of non-formal education, including for young people with fewer opportunities and/ or with special needs, who have at least the basic knowledge in ICT. Our project is targeting professionals who wish to develop their skills and educative practices. Participants must be interested by the topics of the training course and will to get involved into their personal learning, at the same time to use their new skills and knowledge to benefit for their local community once they are back home.

Each partner organization will select 1 to 2 participants according to the aforementioned profile, their motivation for the field concerned, their willingness to open up to a project of European scope, their availability to take part in the project and the contribution that they intend to offer to young people following the project.

We will involve a total of 33 participants coming from 18 Youth organizations from 15 countries , plus 3 trainers and experts in Light mapping show.

AMOUNT COVERED FOR THE TRAVEL*

For travel distances between:

- 100 and 499 KM: 180 EUR per participant,
- 500 and 1999 KM: 275 EUR per participant,
- 2000 and 2999 KM: 360 EUR per participant,
- 3000 and 3999 KM: 530 EUR per participant,

VENUE

Our Training course will take place in Lefkada Island. The Island of Lefkada, also called Lefkas, is the fourth largest island of the Ionian Islands, after Zakynthos, Kefalonia and Corfu. It has an area of 303 square kilometers, a coastline of 117 kilometers and a population of about 23.000 inhabitants. Lefkada is an Island with wide traditions and it is situated 378 km from Athens.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD:

Participants will be hosted in Hotel Lefkas which is in the centre of the city at the seaside very close to cafes, bars, clubs, restaurants, shops, internet café etc.: www.hotellefkas.gr/

TRANSPORTATION

How to arrive to Lefkas

When you arrive to Athens El. Venizelos Airport you have to take the city bus X93 to the bus terminal Kifissos, it will take about 60 minutes and the ticket costs about 5,50 €. There you have to take the bus to Lefkas which takes about 5 hours and costs 32 € (with online booking):

Before departure from Kifissos bus terminal, please inform the driver that you are going to stop in front of the Hotel Lefkas in order to put your luggage on the right side of the bus.
